SOUTH FORK WIND

130 MW

Operational By 2022

35 miles east of Montauk

Connects to grid in East Hampton

SUNRISE WIND

880 MW

Operational by 2024

30 miles east of Montauk

Connects to grid in Smith Point Beach

EMPIRE WIND 1

816 MW

Operational by 2024

14 miles from Jones Beach

Connects to grid in Gowanus, Brooklyn

EMPIRE WIND 2

1,260 MW

Operational post-2026

Adjacent to Empire Wind 1

Connects to grid in Long Beach

BEACON WIND

1,230 MW

Operational post-2026

60 miles east of Montauk

Connects to grid in Astoria through L.I. Sound

ECONOMIC

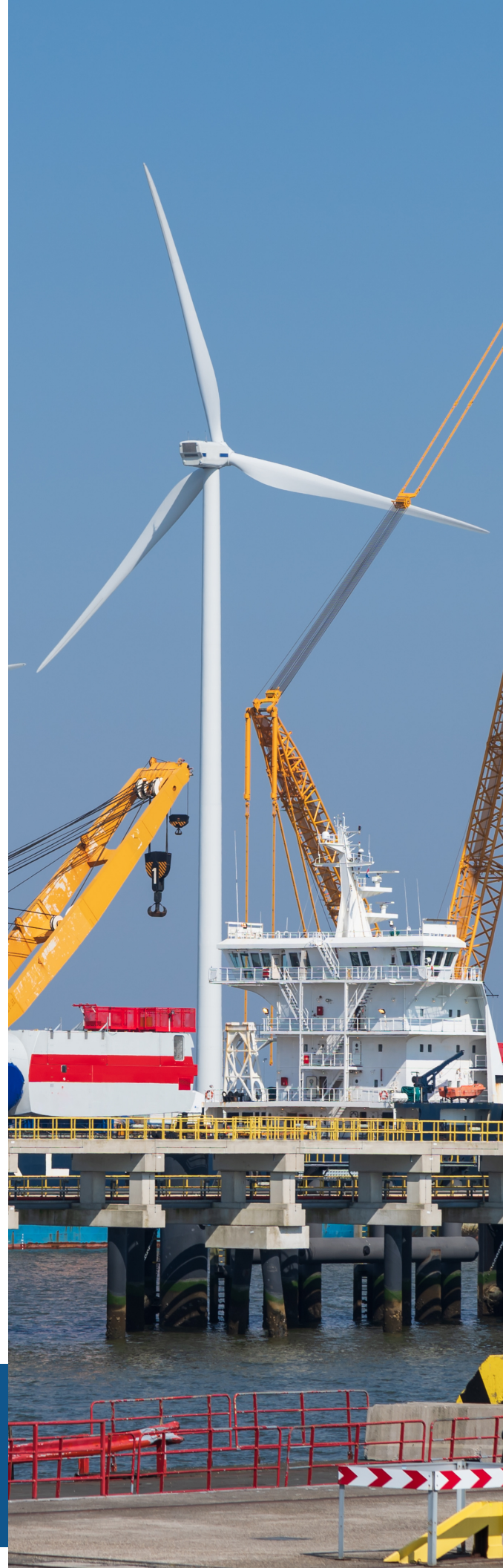
- Over \$12 billion economic impact for the state
